University of Oslo – In short

- Norway's leading university, 207-yrs old, a broad research-intensive university, 8 Faculties, 3 Museums, close cooperation with 2 university hospitals
- **Key figures:** 28 000 students, 2 700 PhD candidates 3 800 academic staff, 6 600 total staff
- Excellence: <u>10 of Norway's 21 current CoE's</u>, 30 % of all national competitive funding, 42 ERC Grant holders and growing EU-revenues (highest in Norway)
- Ranking: Shanghai/ARWU 2017: 62nd in the world
- Interdisciplinary research strategic initiatives: <u>UiO:Energy</u>, <u>UiO:Life Science</u>, <u>UiO:Nordic</u>, <u>UiO:Arctic</u>




Scholars at Risk at UiO

- 2017: Now works as a dentist in Oslo




13 scholar at risk placements at UiO's different departments since 2009

- First policy 2001: host when needed
- From 2009: host every second year
- From 2013: host every year (one or two year stay)
- From 2017: host 4 per year
- Local Budget: ca 100 000 € per hosting one year

Full project title: Strategic partnership to promote core academic values and welcome refugees and threatened academics to European campuses

Project partners: University of Oslo (lead), UNICA Scholars at Risk Network, University of Ljubljana Associate partners: EUA, EAIE

Budget: Duration: 300,000 euros 3 years, Sept 2016 to Aug 2019

- SAIH Member of SAR Norway steering committee




Students at Risk
