The role of universities in regional smart specialisation strategies in Europe

Universities are playing an increasingly important role in the economic, social, technological and cultural development of the regions. The new Cohesion policy framework places specialisation strategies (RIS3) at the heart of regional development. In this context, universities and regions have a unique opportunity to form partnerships, together with the business sector, to maximise the use of European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF).

This Seminar seeks to look deeper into these issues, highlighting the importance of the governance of the individual stakeholders and the partnerships created. It builds on the high level conference organised by the Smart Specialisation Platform (S3P) and the European University Association (EUA), held in Brussels in June 2014, on how to mobilise European Universities in the context of Smart Specialisation.

The main aim of this Seminar is to perform a general analysis of the role of universities in the implementation of the RIS3 and to find out first-hand about cases of European regions where universities' participation is considered a key factor for successful regional development.
